ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Bonney Lake, 9002 Main Street E, Suite 125, Bonney Lake, Washington 98391, until **10:00 am June 7, 2017**, for **SR 410/204TH Avenue E Road Improvement Plans**.

Work to be performed: This Contract provides for the road improvements of SR 410 between its intersection with S Prairie Road E and 208th Avenue E and controller cabinet upgrades along SR 410 between its intersection with 192nd Avenue E and 214th Avenue E, in the City of Bonney Lake, Washington. The project will include widening SR 410 to provide an additional eastbound thru lane and constructing the 204th Avenue E signalized intersection. The south side of SR 410 will be widened east of S Prairie Road E to provide an additional 12-foot thru lane, 5-foot wide shoulder and sidewalk. Controller cabinets will be upgraded at SR 410 and its intersection with 192nd Avenue E, 195th Avenue E, 198th Avenue E, 208th Avenue E, 211th Avenue E, and 214th Avenue E. Work elements include; removal of structures and obstructions, miscellaneous removals, roadway excavation including haul, planing, grading, storm drainage catchment and conveyance system, curb and gutter, sidewalk and ramps, driveways, traffic islands, permanent traffic signal/Illumination systems, controller cabinet replacements, paving, pavement markings, permanent signing, intersection illumination, erosion control, traffic control, and other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications.

Bid proposals will be received only by the City Clerk at the City of Bonney Lake, 9002 Main Street E, Suite 125, Bonney Lake, Washington 98391 by **10:00 am June 7, 2017** at which time they will be opened and read publicly. Clearly identify project name on all submitted bid packages. Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered.

Each bid proposal shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, postal money order, or surety bond in an amount equal to at least 5 percent of the amount of such bid proposal. Checks shall be made payable to the City of Bonney Lake. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Bonney Lake.

The City, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49 C.F.R., Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 23 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award. The City encourages minority and women-owned firms to submit bids consistent with the City's policy to insure that such firms are afforded the maximum practicable opportunity to compete for and obtain public contracts.

The Contractor will be required to comply with all local, State, and Federal laws and regulations pertaining to equal employment opportunities.

The City of Bonney Lake reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities in the bid or in the bidding.

No bidder may withdraw his proposal after the hours set for the opening thereof, or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) calendar days.
