LAKE TAPPS TRESTLE REPAIR PROJECT
ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Bonney Lake, 9002 Main Street E., Bonney Lake, Washington 98391, until **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 4, 2018**, for the **Lake Tapps Trestle Repair Project**.

Work to be performed includes:

The existing 5-foot wide utility bridge supports forced main sewer lines over a Lake Tapps tributary. The existing H-piles have become covered in pack rust with some section loss. As a result, the existing structure requires repairs to the existing four bridge piers. All work will be from the water with minimal impacts to the lake shore. Barges are required and are to be launched from the boat ramp at Allan Yorke Park.

This project consists of driving two 20-inch pipe piles adjacent to each existing bent, installing new straddle and crossbeams, jacking up the existing structure one bent at a time, removing the existing timber cross beams, connection saddles, and H piles. Once demolition, at each bent, is completed install shims between the existing superstructure and the new crossbeams, remove jacking system, bolt crossbeams to the existing superstructure, weld tabs for the brace connections, field apply paint system to areas of the piling that were not shop coated, weld the top plate of the brace connection, install cross bracing and field repair galvanizing.

Piling shall have plant applied coating for marine use and all beams, bracing, and appurtenances shall be galvanized steel.

Bid proposals will be received only by the City Clerk at the City of Bonney Lake, 9002 Main Street E., Bonney Lake, Washington 98391 by **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 4, 2018**, at which time they will be opened and read publicly. Clearly identify the project name on all submitted bid packages. Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered.

The City of Bonney Lake reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities in the bid or in the bidding.

No bidder may withdraw his proposal after the hours set for the opening thereof, or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) calendar days.
