2. **Approval of the October 3, 2011 Notes**

3. **Jail Contracts:**  
*Interim Chief Powers provided the committee with a copy of the 2010 and 2011 jail billings. She let the committee know that Buckley may have to close the jail due to costs of operating the jail/budgets. She will be updating jail contacts with all the jails in the area that they currently use. She would like to have the Buckley contract include*

4. **Proposed Clean up Code:**

*Maili Barber provided a draft ordinance that will provided for applicable RCW's to be incorporated as necessary and will eliminate any unforeseen problems with enforcement of Chapter 9 of the Bonney Lake Code. The draft ordinance has been sent to Dionne's office for review. Committee has not objections to moving forward upon approval from Dionne's office. Place on the Public Safety Agenda.*

5. **Defective Equipment:**

*Maili Barber provided a draft ordinance to allow court staff to accept proof of corrections to defective equipment violations and to dismiss the ticket upon the payment of a \$35.00 nominal administration fee. Committee approves the ordinance and once the City Attorney's office has reviewed, moves forward to council meeting on the Public Safety Agenda.*

6. **WTSC Child Passenger Safety Program Manager Grant:**

Sponsor: Dana Powers

*Interim Chief Powers informed the committee that this is the grant Chief Mitchell had been working on before he left. The program was restructured to fall under Target Zero team.. CC Felez will be the Child Passenger Safety (CPS Program Manager, she is currently working as a Public Education Specialist for the City of Kent in addition to the South King County Target Zero Manager. The committee recommends the grant be moved forward to the Finance Committee and then to full council for approval. This will be a zero cost to the City.*

7. **Open Discussion:**

*Maili Barber expressed concerns about the WSU Forest trails and asked if there was anyway that the trails could be made accessible for patrol cars to regular patrols of the area. The city does have access to the green gate; however the access road is not very good. Mark Hamilton's goal is to have signs posted that the area is patrolled.*

*Laurie Carter provided a video she received on domestic violence "Shout" the story of domestic violence and gave to Kathy to share with others and wondered if there was a way that this could be set up to play in a general area for anyone to view.*
