Only Washington State licensed fire sprinkler contractors shall be permitted to conduct design, alterations, maintenance or installation work on automatic fire sprinkler systems. This shall include both the underground and above ground portions of the system. Proof of licensure shall be submitted at the time of application.

Please contact East Pierce Fire & Rescue at least 24 hours in advance to witness/conduct all required tests and inspections.
