utility services may be contingent upon fulfillment of applicable conditions, such as building system improvements, as well as payment of various costs and fees.

I further acknowledge that if the project for which I seek this certification is a **preliminary** short plat or subdivision, I will be required to construct facilities necessary for water and or sewer connections in compliance with the Bonney Lake Municipal Code and adopted standards. If the project for which I seek this certification is a **final** short plat, subdivision, building permit, or septic design, I must build out the system and connect it to the existing Bonney Lake utility system located at the site indicated on this certificate.

I understand that this certification is valid for a three (3) year period starting on the date of the City Engineer's signature. I must execute developer extensions agreements within this three year period or else file a new application for utility extension with the City.

I acknowledge that this certification is non-transferable. New property owners will need to request a new water certification.

I acknowledge that developer extensions may be required based on City Code and standards.
